


AMPO Legislative Priorities

- House (435 Seats): Nov 5, 2024
- **Senate (33 Seats):** Nov 5, 2024
 - Congress in Session: Jan 3, 2025
- Presidency: Nov 5, 2024
 - Inauguration Day: Jan 20, 2025

• **IIJA expires:** Sep 30, 2026
